

How our Awards work

Net Zero Commitment & Targets

- Existence of a formal Net Zero pledge.
- Target year for Net Zero.
- Scope of emissions covered (Scopes 1, 2, 3).
- Alignment with recognized standards (e.g., SBTi).

Baseline & Emissions Inventory

- Clarity of baseline year chosen.
- Methodology/framework used (GHG Protocol, ISO, etc.).
- Progress made in reducing emissions since the baseline.

Governance & Accountability

- Board/C-suite oversight.
- Policies, incentives, and structures for accountability.

Decarbonization Strategy

- Concrete measures taken/planned across short-, medium-, and long-term.
- Technologies, operational changes, or business model shifts.

Renewable Energy & Energy Efficiency

- Current share of renewable energy.
- Roadmap for achieving 100% renewable energy.
- Energy efficiency measures.

Value Chain & Scope 3 Engagement

- Engagement with suppliers, customers, partners.
- Requirements, collaborations, and incentives for Scope 3 reduction.

Offsets & Removals

- Approach to offsets (proportion of reliance, residual only).
- Quality standards (Gold Standard, Verra, Article 6).
- Integration with SBTi guidelines.

Transparency & Reporting

- Participation in frameworks like CDP, TCFD, GRI, ISSB.
- Public reporting of progress.

Innovation & Technology Integration

- Investments in R&D, climate innovation, and emerging technologies.
- Use of AI, green hydrogen, carbon capture, etc.

Impact Measurement & Just Transition

- Integration with broader sustainability (biodiversity, water, circularity).
- Commitment to social equity/just transition.
- Evidence of measurable co-benefits.

Nominate your Organisation

Entries will be judged on commitment to Net Zero, strong governance, and clear strategies, backed by innovation and transparency. Emphasis will be on renewable energy adoption, value-chain engagement, responsible offsets, and measurable impact that ensures a just and inclusive transition.
